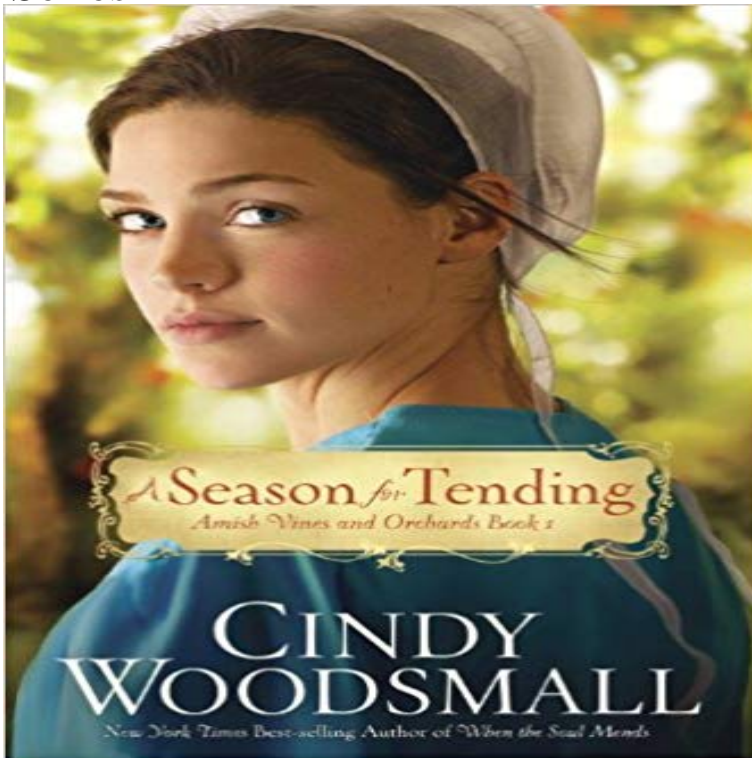


## A Season for Tending: Book One in the Amish Vines and Orchards Series
