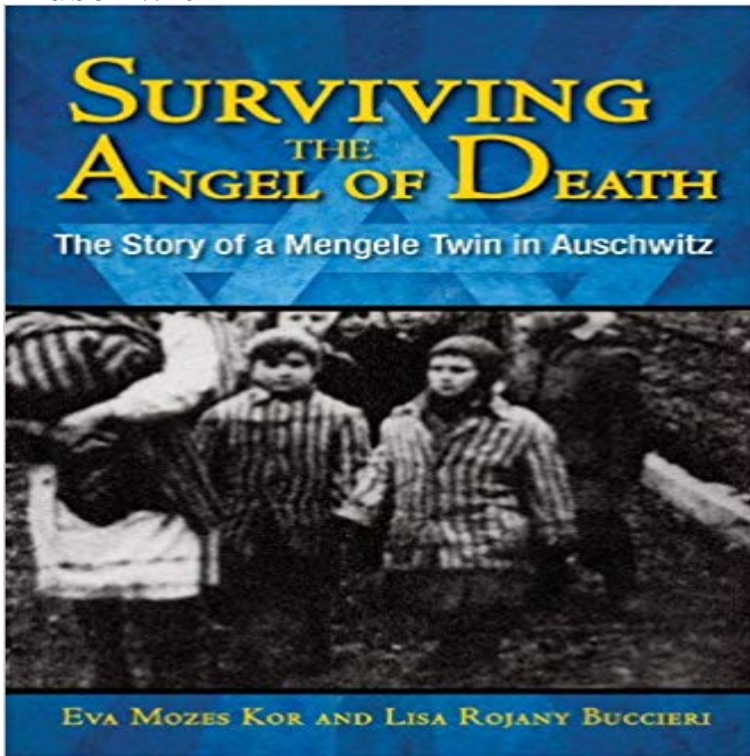


Surviving the Angel of Death: The Story of a Mengele Twin in Auschwitz
