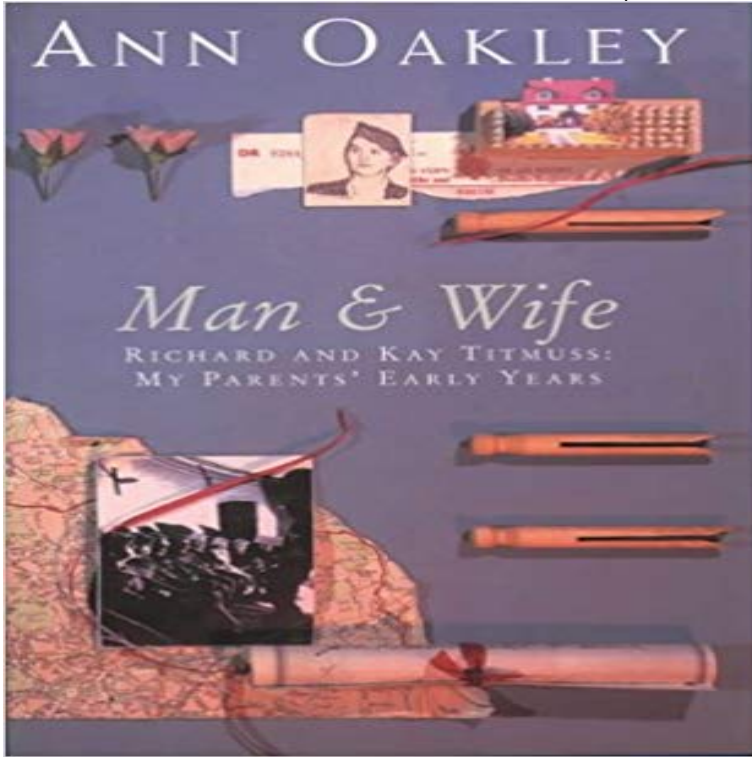


Man and Wife: Richard and Kay Titmuss - My Parents Early Years
