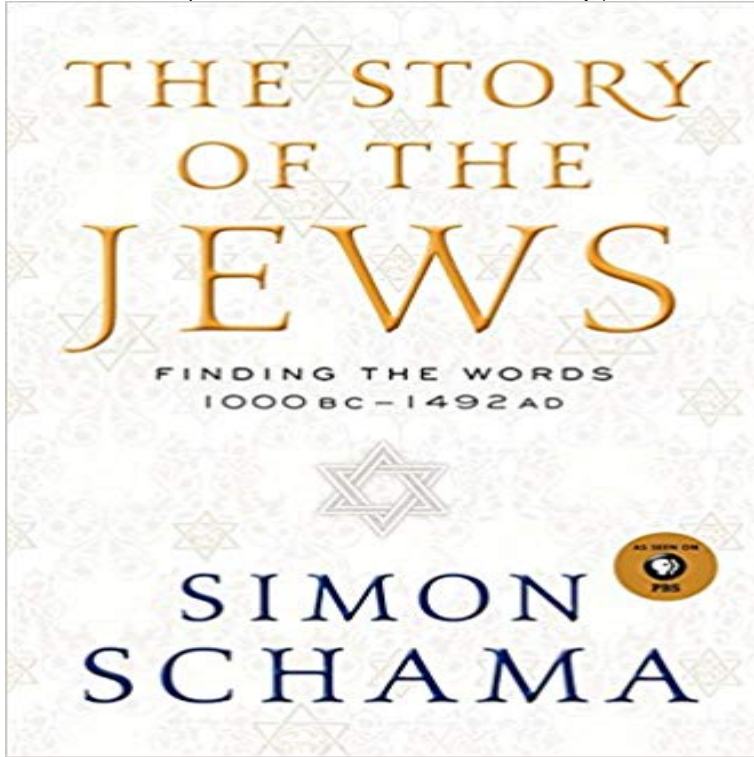


The Story of the Jews: Finding the Words 1000 BC - 1492 AD
