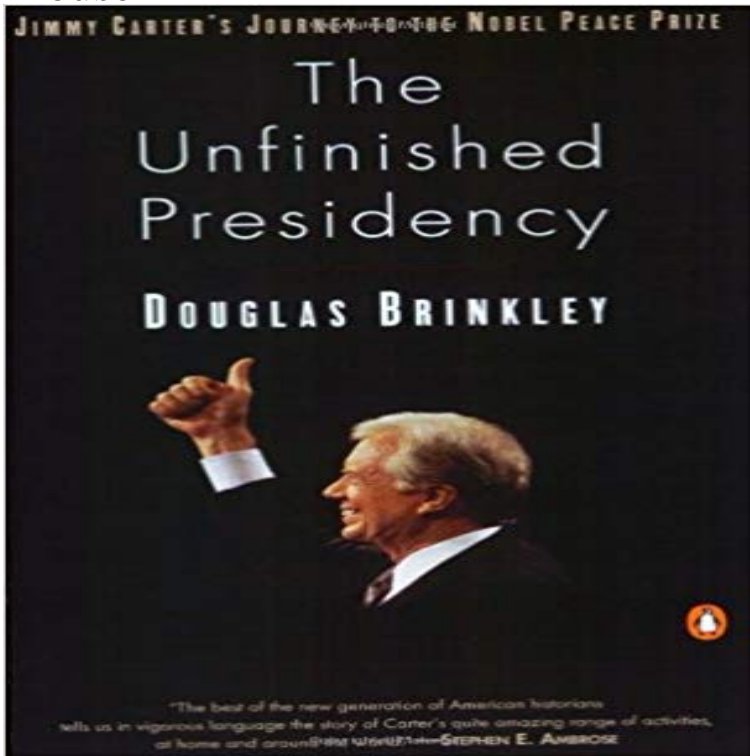


The Unfinished Presidency: Jimmy Carters Journey Beyond the White House
